In place of the eyesore hoardings at the station, there will be a major new public square, befitting the international reputation of the Palace

The traffic outside this site is a nightmare, which will be made better by a significant investment in the road network, replacing the traffic gyratory with a simplified road network and traffic lights next to the bridge

It will be good to go to a small foodstore outside the station, and the station itself needs to be modernised and refurbished

I am pleased the developers have reduced the time of the construction by 14 months, with the use of a temporary car park on Cigarette Island, and I am pleased they are using recycled plastic matting to reduce damage to the park itself

With almost no development on the Jolly Boatman site, there's a massive reduction in density and development on that part of the site; and overall the density of this scheme is comparable with the approved scheme

I understand why the developer needed to raise the height of the homes, albeit by just 5 foot 10 inches, to ensure the maximum possible space for the public square and a good visual link to Cigarette Park

The developer will pay over £2 million to improve infrastructure in the wider area

This is a first class traditional design, by architects Allies and Morrison. It will have a beneficial effect on the character and appearance of the conservation area Support for public square at Hampton Court Station, and development at the station site
