Comment: We object to the development on the grounds of the following :

1. Design is not sympathetic to the original railway station style , not in keeping with the buildings opposite or indeed Hampton Court Palace itself .The design of all the buildings looks like cheap square boxes with no thought to the architectural style of the area at all .
2. The buildings are too dense for the space and too tall at 1.5 m taller than the previous proposals . The number of buildings should be reduced to lessen their impact .
3. The effect of the visual amenity from and to Hampton Court Palace is detrimental . This is one of the most popular UK visitor attractions and the visual amenity should be preserved .
- 4.The parking available is inadequate to cope with the increased traffic which would result from the flats and hotel in an area already plagued with major traffic and parking problems .
5. The entrance by road to the development is located in a very dangerous place . Traffic coming over the bridge often travels too fast , so accidents are bound to happen if motorists see the entrance too late , brake etc .
