Preserving the unique character of the land with TPO trees should be a priority in any development decision.

Furthermore, the development's potential impact on biodiversity and habitat for mammals (including bats) is deeply concerning. The destruction of natural habitats could lead to a decline in local wildlife populations, disrupting the delicate balance of the ecosystem. I implore the planning authority to prioritise the preservation of these habitats which is essential in the face of ongoing climate challenge. Ecological harm is unimaginable.

In conclusion, I request that the planning authority carefully considers the objections raised, conducts comprehensive assessments that prioritises public safety and environmental conservation rather than making profits for developers. It is crucial to ensure a sustainable and harmonious future for the community.
