Comment: I have looked at the revised planning document and apart from the revised location and swept path analysis. The developers have not commented on the increased traffic expected on Claygate Lane, particularly during school opening and closing times and the gridlock it will cause.

The ecology consultants document which lays bare the expected biodiversity loss of 58% also appears to be conveniently unanswered. Even, if we take last years regulations, there should be no biodiversity loss, as a result of the development. This is an urban area and any green patches of land should be retained for the mental and physical well being of the local population. If they were to increase biodiversity elsewhere, it would not be of benefit to any of the locals affected by this development that no one wants.
